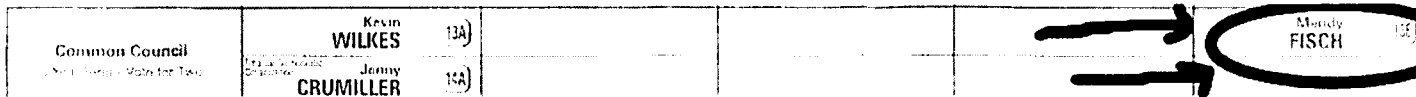


Politically-involved Princeton residents support Mendy Fisch for Borough Council
